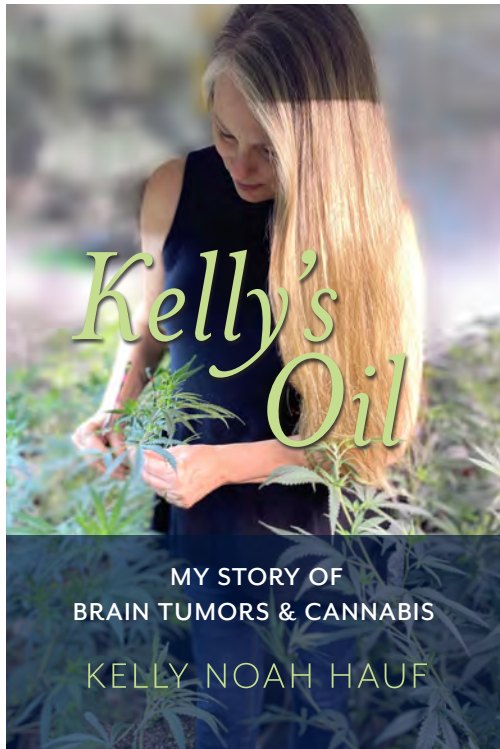

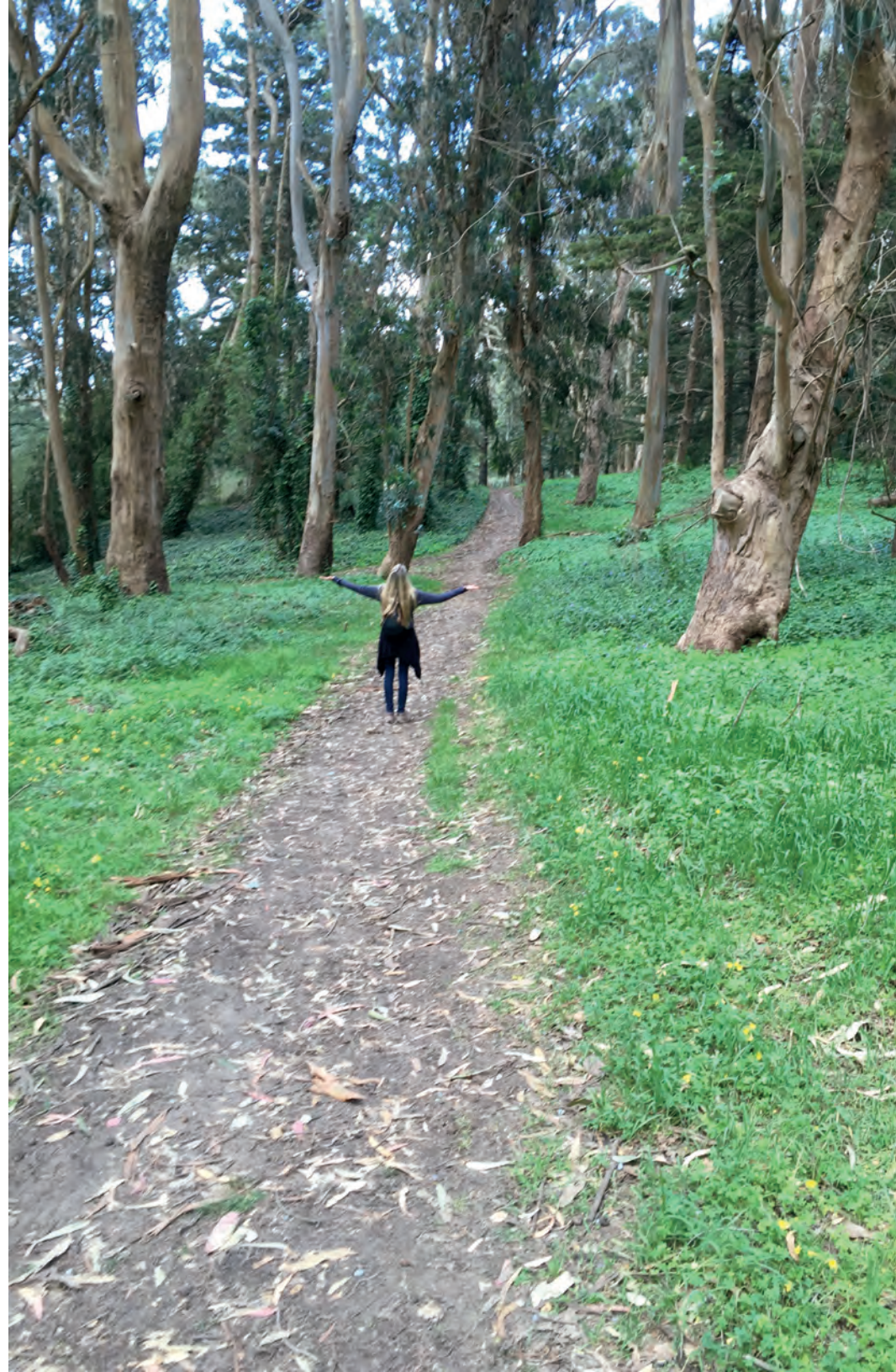

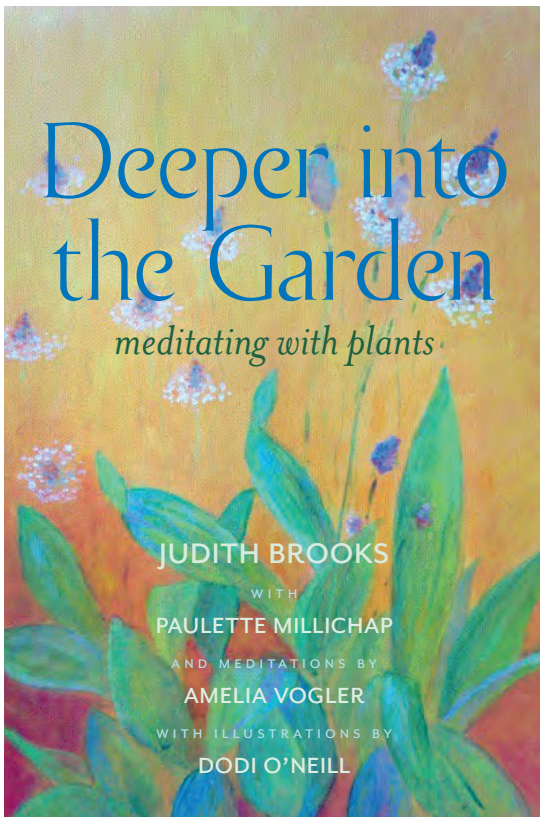

THE RETURN

I came back to North Carolina in 2012, after living away for almost forty years, and moved back into my childhood home. I'm not sure what a ghost is, but since being home, I can hear my mother's voice. She loved plants and understood them in a deep way. I still remember as a child her telling me to go out to the garden and to listen to the corn to hear what it needed. I came home to listen to the corn and to enter more deeply into communion with plants and the land where I grew up.

I have been the publisher of many Native American stories, especially Native elder Joseph Roal, known as Beautiful Painted Arrow. Grandfather Joseph had a vision in 1983 to build round, teepee-like structures in the earth where people could share for the growth and health of the oceans and rivers and oceans of the world. Joseph called these structures Sound Chambers. In his vision he was shown how to build chambers on the sound world he imagined like a singing boat. Many of these chambers have been built around the world and are used for chanting, ceremony, and prayer.

Since Joseph had told me there was a Sound Chamber nearby.

Borage

Let Nature be your teacher.

Borage grows throughout Europe and North America and is an annual plant that self-seeds easily in the garden. The beautiful star-shaped blue flowers are rich in nectar and attract many bees to the garden, hence the name "Bee Plant." Borage flowers have prominent black growth centers known as anthers, where the pollen of the flower is released.

The leaves and stems have coarse hairs and a cucumber-like fragrance is released when rubbing a leaf between your fingers. In Europe borage leaves are used as a culinary herb in soups and the flowers added to herbal tea or cordons. I like to plant borage in my vegetable garden as a "companion plant" for tomatoes and cabbages because it is said to help reduce the numbers of tomato hornworms and cabbage worms in the garden.

Borage has been used in European herbology for centuries and is especially known to dispel melancholy; help restore the appetite for people who are exhausted and to treat coughs and sore throats.

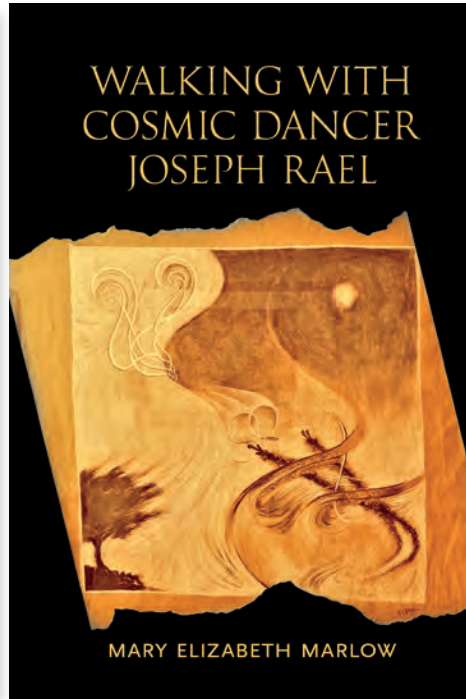
Joseph's grandfather at Picuris Pueblo was a cacique. A cacique is the spiritual leader of the tribe with the special gift for traveling to other worlds or dimensions to bring back gifts of wisdom and beauty for the people.

When Joseph was seven he and other children in the tribe were gathered around his grandfather listening to the winter tales, special stories that taught the origins and values of the people. There was snow outside but the pinion fire in the adobe room was warm. Grandfather spoke and said to Joseph and the children, "You think you know who you are and what is real, but there is more than your eyes can see." Grandfather started walking toward a picture of a spring meadow that hung on the wall in the room. Grandfather walked all the way into the picture and disappeared into the painted meadow. A few minutes passed as Joseph and the children looked on in stunned silence then Grandfather emerged from the painting carrying a bouquet of flowers. "When you travel into another world," Grandfather said, "you must always bring back something physical as a gift for the people. Grandfather handed a white daisy to each of the children. 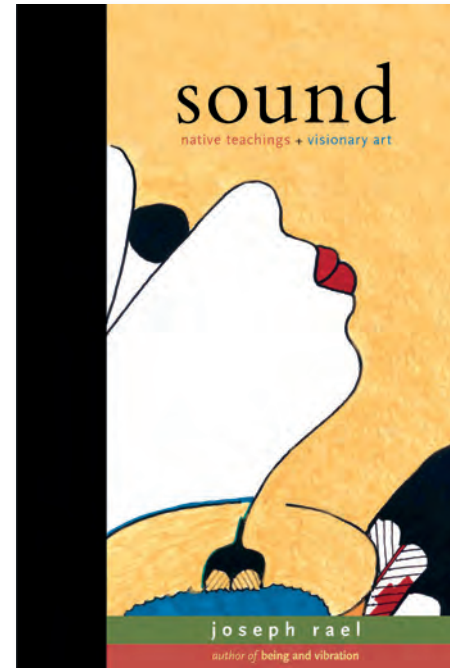
Now a cacique himself, Joseph gives us the *New World Oracle*, as the gift he brings back from travels to other worlds.



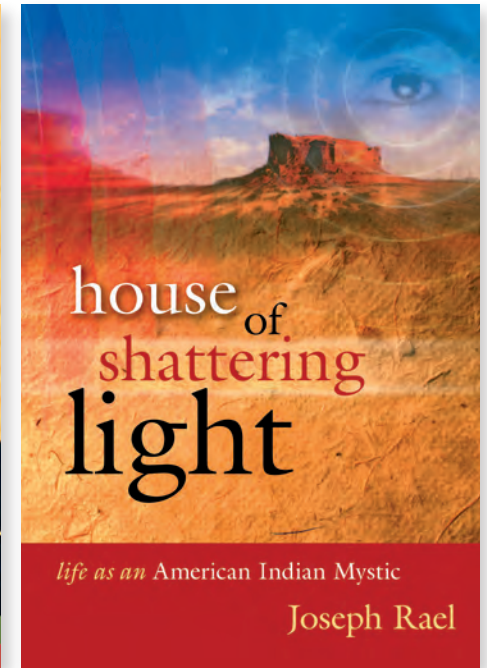

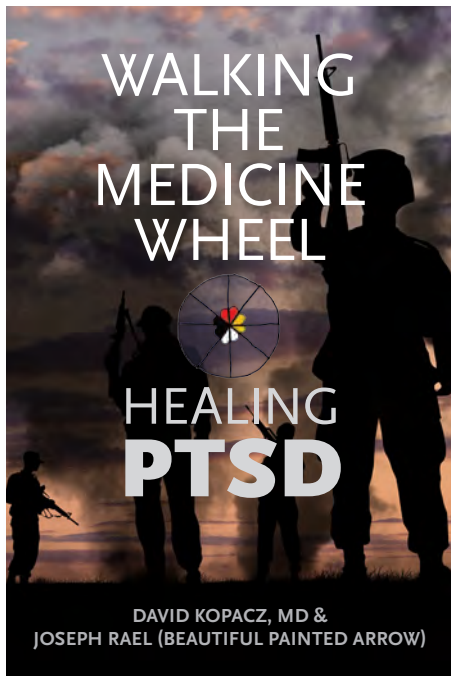

Psychiatrist and holistic & integrative physician, David Kopacz, and Native American Visionary, Joseph Rael (Beautiful Painted Arrow), create a healing path to help our veterans suffering trauma and PTSD to come home. Even when out of the war zone, combat-readiness persists in the veterans' nervous system. This book uses the circular pathway of the medicine wheel to re-train that nervous system.

Rather than viewing trauma, obstacles and disappointments as negatives, the medicine wheel offers a way of transforming these events into opportunities for personal growth. Walking the medicine wheel is walking a spiritual path – integrating body-emotion-mind-spirit, within the circle of the four directions. The book provides practical exercises of guided imagery and ceremony to help returning veterans feel they have a purpose and have something, not only of value, but, of critical importance to give to their families and their communities.



Joseph Rael, whose Tiwa name is *Tsluuteh-koh-ay*, Beautiful Painted Arrow, is a visionary healer. He is the author of

many books, including *Sound, Being @ Vibration* and *Ceremonies of the Living Spirit*. He holds a Master's degree in Political Science from the University of Wisconsin. He has worked to create holistic health care using Native American traditions to help those suffering with addictions. He has been recognized by the United Nations for his work creating Peace Chambers on four continents.
